

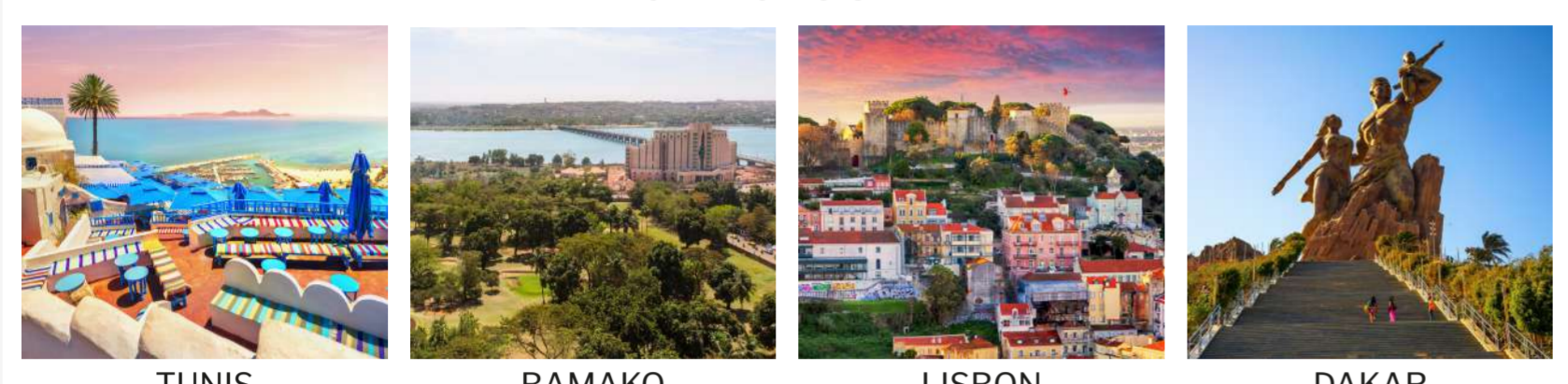

Myanmar Airways International (MAI) is a privately owned airline headquartered in Yangon, Myanmar. From its bases in Yangon and Mandalay, the country's two largest cities, MAI connects to some of Asia's most prominent cities, serving Thailand, Malaysia, China, and India. The airline's hallmark 'MAI Experience' is built on comfort and subtle cultural traditions, while MAI's modern fleet consists of four Airbus A319s, two A320s, and two Embraer 190s. In April, an ATR 72-600 was added to support regional network growth at MAI and its sister airline, Mingalar (formerly called Air KBZ).
