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## AIRLINEPROS TRAINING PROGRAMS FOR THE AVIATION INDUSTRY, BY AVIATION PROFESSIONALS

I hope the year so far has been good to you all – as it has been to aviation. As you may have already heard, air travel is going through the sky, and the numbers have surpassed pre-pandemic figures in most places. As with any industry growing at the rate that air travel is, there will be a need for a large number of trained personnel to support this sector. Just some tip of the iceberg projections: While Boeing expects the commercial aircraft fleet to double by 2042 and says close to 650,000 pilots will be needed, Airbus estimates the pilot number also close to 600,000.

Pieter Elbers, CEO of IndiGo, among the fastest-growing airlines in the world, and one of our airline partners, put it very succinctly in a recent interview: "Every one rupee invested in aviation returns more than three rupees to the broader economy." In his typical illustrative manner, driving further home the point, Elbers also noted that one aircraft generates 100 direct jobs and 600 related jobs. Though he said this within the Indian context, these numbers are not way off the mark elsewhere. Besides IndiGo's record-setting order of 500 aircraft in 2023, many other airline majors have been on an ordering spree which reinstates the array of opportunities that will come by directly or indirectly in the aviation sector.

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
