

HIGHLIGHT OF VIETNAM & CAMBODIA

17 DAYS - 16 NIGHTS

DAY 1: HANOI-ARRIVAL (D)

Upon arrival in Hanoi, you will be greeted by our tour guide and transferred to hotel to hotel for check in. Welcome drink will be served at check in time (*Normally the check in time is 14:00*).

In the afternoon, we will have a short walking tour around the **Hoan Kiem Lake** (Lake of restored sword) with visit of **Ngoc Son temple, Grand Theatre** and **Saint Joseph Cathedral**, passing the ancient **Indochine bank**.

Late in the afternoon: Enjoy **Water Puppet Show**, a traditional Vietnamese water performing art, at which Vietnamese folk tales, history and local lives are introduced via colorful puppets. **Cyclo tour** around the old quarter of Hanoi.

Dinner at a Michellin Guided restaurant

Overnight in Hanoi

DAY 2: HANOI – SAPA (B, D)

Breakfast at hotel. We depart to **Lao Cai (245km)**. It takes about 5 hours traveling the new highway to Lao Cai. You have the opportunity to admire the beautiful scenery of the region along the way. Arrive in Sapa, check in hotel & relax. Lunch at your own expense

In the afternoon, we take a walking tour of Sapa for a visit to the busy market where Red Dao, Black H'mong and other ethnic minority people converge from the surrounding countryside to sell their embroidery, silverware and handicrafts, and to buy provisions. Take souvenir photos at **Sapa Stone Church**, Sapa lake...etc..

Dinner at restaurant with Salmon Hot Pot

Overnight in Sapa.

DAY 3: SAPA- TAVAN- LAO CHAI VILLAGE (B, L)

Wake up and enjoy the fresh air and atmosphere of Sapa. Breakfast at hotel. In the morning, trek to visit **Lao Chai – Ta Van village**, exploring the local ethnic minorities life, admire the spectacular natural scenery with the terraced rice fields. Return to Sapa town, lunch at local restaurant.

Free time at your leisure then. Overnight in Sapa

DAY 4: SAPA – HANOI (B, L)

Breakfast at hotel. Free time at your leisure then before we will have lunch and be back to Hanoi in late evening. Overnight in Hanoi.

DAY 5: HANOI – HALONG BAY (B, L, D)

Breakfast at hotel. We depart to **Ha Long**, passing through the rich farmland of the Red River Delta, enjoy the lush scenery and have chance for taking photograph. Halong Bay, listed as a World Heritage Area of outstanding natural beauty. “Dragon descending to the sea” as it is known in Vietnamese, picturesque Halong Bay has more than 2,000 limestone islets rising from the sea, many of them containing beautiful grottoes. Upon arrival at Halong, we embark on a boat trip to cruise discovering this magnificent UNESCO World Wonder. Lunch on board. This is a great journey among surreal islands rising from a tranquil emerald sea. We will explore Sung Sot Cave, one of the most beautiful caves in the bay, join a cooking demonstration on the sundeck, passing Dinh Huong Island, Ga Choi Island, Dog Island, Sail Island, Titov Beach, watch a splendid sunset on the bay. In the late afternoon, we anchor for the night on the bay and enjoy a delicious seafood dinner on board. *Overnight on the junk.*

DAY 6: HALONG BAY – HANOI (B, Br)

Early morning coffee and tea will be served on the sundeck followed by a Tai Chi class. Breakfast on board. Then you continue exploring the magnificent Ha Long Bay. We'll take a rowing boat to explore the Luon Cave by passing through the pretty entrance to come across a tranquil round lake, surrounded by luxuriant trees and high stone walls. Return to the junk. Lunch on board. Check out, then drive back to Hanoi. Overnight in Hanoi

DAY 7: HANOI – CITY TOUR – HUE (FLIGHT) (B, L)

Breakfast at hotel. Today, we continue our exploration of Hanoi, a charming city with perfect combination of the Orient and the West resulted from the Vietnamese interesting history. Visit the picturesque **West Lake** and its sixth century **Tran Quoc Pagoda**, the most ancient pagoda in Hanoi with its history line of more than 1,500 years. Then we'll visit **Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum (exterior)**, **Ho Chi Minh's house on stilts**, **President Palace**, **One Pillar Pagoda**. Have a lunch before transfer to Noi Bai airport for your flight to Hue.

Meet local guide and transfer to hotel for check in Overnight in Hue

DAY 8: HUE – FULL DAY CITY (B, L)

Breakfast at hotel. In the morning, we will take a boat on the **Perfume River** to **Thien Mu Pagoda**, which is the oldest pagoda in Hue. We continue to visit the **Imperial Citadel** is the home of Vietnam's last royal dynasty – the Nguyen Dynasty (including the Flag Tower, Noon Gate, Nine Dynastic Urns, Nine Holy Cannons, Thai Hoa Palace and Forbidden Purple City). Lunch at local restaurant.

In the afternoon, we'll visit the **tomb of King Tu Duc** (built from 1864-1867), which is considered as one of the most beautiful and picturesque and largest works of architecture of Nguyen Dynasty's royal palaces and tombs. Continue driving to the **Conical hat village**, we'll spend about 20 minutes visiting and seeing local people make conical hats. Return to hotel. Evening: **enjoy Hue traditional music on boat**. Overnight in Hue.

DAY 9: HUE – DANANG - HOI AN (B, L)

Breakfast at hotel.

Depart Hue for Danang across the **Hai Van Pass** (Pass of the Ocean Clouds), passing through many pretty red-tiled villages with fruit orchards, enjoying spectacular views of sky and sea.

Upon arrival in Danang, transfer to visit **Cham Museum**, continue to pass **Marble Mountain** and **Non Nuoc beach** and then drive to Hoi An. *Lunch at local restaurant*. Walking tour in Hoi An - Discover the historic town which used to be a prosperous seaport city during the 16th to 18th centuries. Its sizeable community of foreign merchants resulted in a unique architectural style with Vietnamese, Chinese and Japanese influences. We will visit the former merchants' houses, **Chinese Temple & pagoda**, **Museum of History**, the 400-year-old **Japanese Covered Bridge** and the colorful market. Check in to the hotel. Overnight in Hoi An

DAY 10: HOI AN – TRA QUE VILLAGE-HOI AN (B, L)

Tra Que is a charming little village on the edge of Hoi An, the village is famous for its sweet scented and fresh vegetables that spice up on the daily meals of Hoi An people: Cao Lau and Quang noodles. Come here, you will have a chance to discover the art of cultivating and water plants, tasting and doing a cooking class with local dishes.

Breakfast at hotel. Transfer by bus to the **Tra Que village**. You will be welcomed and introduced about the history of the village. Take a bicycle ride around the vegetable garden and join with the farmers in preparing the land and fertilizing with seaweed from the local lake. Continue doing some next steps such as: raking the ground, sowing, watering greens, picking greens and many

more gardening activities. Spend the rest of the morning working the land in honored way, before having a break to prepare lunch with Chef. Your lunch consists of many local delicacies including "tam huu" spring roll, 'banh xeo' or local pancake.

After lunch, we return to Hoi An for a bit of free time. Overnight in Hoi An

DAY 11: HOI AN – DANANG - HO CHI MINH (FLIGHT) (B, L)

Breakfast at hotel. Transfer to Danang airport for the flight to **Ho Chi Minh** (the former Saigon, also known as the "Pearl of Indochina").

Upon arrival, transfer to hotel for check in. Lunch at local restaurant. In the afternoon, we'll visit **China Town** with Thien Hau Temple, built in 1863 by the ethnic Chinese of Saigon and dedicated to the Goddess of the Sea and Binh Tay Market. Continue to visit the **Lacquer factory**, the **Notre Dame Cathedral** and the **Old Post Office** (built between 1877 and 1883, is an excellent example of classic French colonial architecture) and the **Reunification Palace** (former President palace). Return to hotel. The rest of day is free at leisure. Overnight in Ho Chi Minh.

DAY 12: HO CHI MINH – CU CHI TUNNEL – HO CHI MINH (B, L, D)

Breakfast at hotel. Morning **Cu Chi tunnels tour**. This journey out of the city centre to the Cu Chi regions, where you will visit the vast underground network of tunnels built first as a defence against the French, and later expanded during the American war. It was from here that the North Vietnamese waged their guerrilla warfare and you will marvel at their ingenuity and resilience. See secret trapdoors, underground kitchens, living areas and meeting rooms. The more adventurous may explore the deeper second, and even third level tunnels. For those preferring to remain above ground, there is ample opportunity to view excavated areas from above. Your guide will advise you of the length and level of difficulty of each tunnel before entering - some are easily accessed by stairs. After that, we drive back to Ho Chi Minh City in the afternoon and visit the **War Remnants Museum**. Enjoy **the dinner with traditional music** on boat along Saigon River. Overnight in Ho Chi Minh City.

DAY 13: HO CHI MINH – MY THO – HO CHI MINH (B, L)

Breakfast at hotel. Depart to My Tho (2hours). On the way, we stop to visit the Cao Daism Temple. Arrive **My Tho**, visit Vinh Trang pagoda an oldest ancient one in Southern Vietnam. Known as the largest pagoda and the most special architecture in **Mekong Delta**. It's architecture was influenced by Vietnamese culture and Khmer's culture as well as European's architecture.

After that, we'll get on a motor boat. Take a leisurely boat ride in Tien River to enjoy fresh air, to see the peaceful life of the local people, Passing the stilt house, the fishing floating farm, the four Islands (Dragon, Phoenix, Tortoise, Unicorn)

After passing Rach Mieu bridge, we disembark at Thoi Son Islet that locates on Phoenix Island. Take a leisurely walking on the village paths, visit local people's home, orchard garden and enjoy seasonal fruits while listening to traditional Southern folk music.

Then visit honey bee farm and taste delicious honey tea with lemon that is really good for health.

Take a hand- rowed sampan through the creeks for sightseeing the natural water coconut trees a symbol in the Delta areas.

Return to the motorbike boat then cruising to visit coconut candy workshop to know how to make delicious candies by hand. *The highlight of the trip is taking a sightseeing through the peaceful villages by horse cart.*

Lunch in the garden with specialties (dried Ear Elephant fish). Return to Ho Chi Minh city. Overnight in Ho Chi Minh

DAY 14: HO CHI MINH – FLIGHT TO SIEM REAP (B/D)

Breakfast at hotel. Free at your leisure before transfer to Ho Chi Minh Airport for the flight to Siem Reap

Chum Reap Sour! Welcome to Siem Reap is the center of Angkor!

Upon arrival, you will be met English Tour Guide at the Siem Reap airport.

Start your first visit to Royal Residence & Royal Garden & the Copper Statue of Angkorian Warriors and the nearby of the Preah Ang Chek Preah Ang Chorm Shrine for pray luck. Then stop at Wat Bo, the oldest pagoda which contains very unique wall paintings of the Reamker (Ramayana).

Then stop at Made in Cambodia Market, live entertainment artists & workshops will round out the market's festive and diverse offerings. The main philosophy behind the Made in Cambodia Market is to Help Create Khmer Jobs; from the villagers producing the Handicrafts to the sellers interacting with the visitors. (Open from 1200PM onward)

Then Proceed to hotel check-in in the evening, enjoy Dinner together with 01hour shopping at Angkor Night Market & stroll along Pub Street.

Overnight in Siem Reap at your selected hotel.

DAY 15: SIEM REAP – FULL DAY TOUR IN ANGKOR (B, L)

Breakfast at hotel.

Start the temple excursion by enter the **South Gate of Angkor Thom Temple** and marvel the wonders of the eerie **Bayon, Baphoun, Phimeanakas, the Elephants terrace and terrace of Leper King**. Before lunch, visit **Ta Prohm Temple** the photogenic and atmospheric combination of trees growing out of the ruins and the jungle surroundings have made it one of Angkor's most popular temples with many visitors.

Lunch will be served at local restaurant.

In afternoon, visit to the famous **Angkor Wat**, built for king Suryavarman II in the early 12th century. It is believed to be built as a temple & mausoleum for King at the peak of the Khmer empire. Enjoy to visit the temple till sundown.

In the evening, proceed to have dinner together with **APSARA Dance Show** at local restaurant.

Overnight in Siem Reap

Visitor Code of Conduct for Temple Visit:

- *Dress Code: Revealing clothes such as shorts and skirts above the knees and showing the bare shoulders are prohibited in sacred places. Respectful dress is strongly encouraged in Angkor.*
- *Smoking Cigarettes inside the temple are prohibited.*
- *The Bakan Tower (Central Tower) of Angkor Wat Temple always closes on the Buddhist Sabbath Days; the Buddhist religious days (four days a month). You cannot climb up the tower.*

DAY 16: SIEM REAP – BANTEAY SREI – ROLUOS GROUP (B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel.

Spend your last day to visit **Banteay Srey**, meaning “citadel of the women” or, “citadel of beauty”. People speculate that this is due to its miniature scale, the pink colour of the limestone, and the elaborate decorative carvings of many devatas (minor female deities) that grace its walls. Stop at **Preah Dak Village** for learn about how the sugar palm and palm juice has been made in traditional style. Have lunch at local restaurant.

In afternoon, visit **Roluos Group**, the first major capital of the Angkorian-era Khmer Empire.

It has become known as the ‘Roluos Group’ due to its proximity to the modern town of Roluos. Roluos Group contains brick temple of:

- **Lolei, & Preah Ko Temple**, that named in honor of Shiva’s mount.



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- **Bakong temple** is a giant pyramid, its cardinal points marked by giant elephants. It is surrounded by typical Cambodian scenery of rice paddies and sugar palm trees. **Enjoy sunset view from Bakong Temple.**

Return to hotel for refresh then heading to dinner in local restaurant.

Overnight in Siem Reap.

DAY 17: SIEM REAP- DEPARTURE (B)

Breakfast at hotel. Free time at your leisure till transfer to airport for departure flight.
